Industrial Chaos Will Shape Better World, Atkins Asserts

Birmingham Rotarians were told Monday noon by Rev. Robert M. Atkins, local Methodist minister, that out of the present industrial world chaos, caused by a lack of group social intelligence, will come better days for men and women here and girls.

"Today's depression cannot be laid to prohibition, nor to Communism, Socialism, or any other class of people—it rests entirely in the hands of our capitalist system. I am confident that capitalism will remain with us, but in a more humanitarian sense," declared the speaker, who was the guest of Dr. George F. Haynal, who introduced him.

"Under the present capitalist system, profits seem to be the sole motive for the carrying on of business. I admit that profit is a necessary consideration in the conduct of business, but it should not be given precedence over the human equation," stated Rev. Atkins.

Blames War

"We are the product of generations of people whose greatest folly was consummated in the World War—a war that gave industry and the money instincts of mankind a greater impetus than anything ever did before. We are now paying for part of that folly in our industrial depression, which is a natural by-product of an inflamed world—a world that also gave vent to its money-madness in a rising stock market that trembled and fell in 1929."

"Cooperation is the life of trade—competition is the death of traders, in my opinion. Some once said that 'no man is entitled to that which he has not, in some
