

FISHING ON INLAND LAKES ENDS APR. 1

All Angling To Cease Except On Certain "Pike and Trout" Lakes Lansing, March 12.—Fishing will cease in Michigan's inland lakes Apr. 1, when non-trout rivers and streams will be open for spearing for certain species. All fishing will cease Apr. 1 in all inland lakes of the state until May 25, except on designated "pike" and "trout" lakes in which fishing will be permitted after May 1 for perch, walleyed pike, grass pike, muskellunge and non-game fish, and all species of trout.

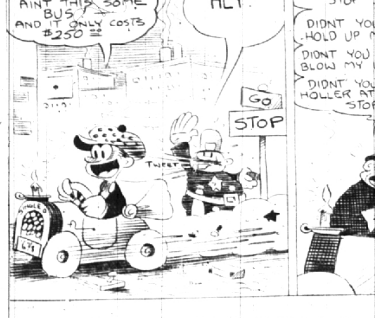

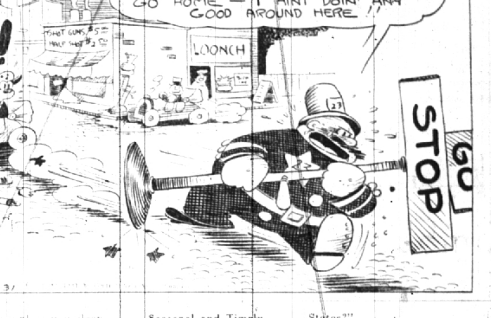
