RIVER ROUGE IS B.H.S. FOE

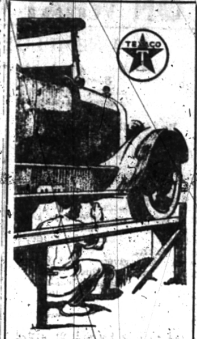
Baldwin Affirmative Debaters Slated For S. M. F. L. Contest Tonight
