Offer Scrip To Teachers The scrip, in denominations of five, ten and one hundred dollars, will be offered to the public through both Birmingham banks and through the office of the Board at Baldwin High School.

Mr. Vliet said, "I am sure that the scrip will be accepted by the teachers in the regular winter taxes, due Dec. 10. All scrip will bear 6 per cent interest, payable in six months."

Thus, the Board feels, persons may buy the scrip either as an investment or to be used in payment of their school taxes, and provide the Board with the temporary funds necessary to keep the schools open, without any hardship on those who desire to cooperate.
