## Join Hoover Credit Pool

AT A MEETING held Monday afternoon at the Statler Hotel in Detroit, over 400 bankers of the southern peninsula of Michigan organized what will be known as Association No. 2 of Federal Reserve District No. 7 of the National Credit Corporation, and will be associated with similar groups throughout the entire United States.

The National Credit Corporation will operate in the following manner: Banks throughout the nation will subscribe money to the corporation in proportion to their size, and from this huge pool any bank in the group may borrow on its securities needed to tide it over any periods of unusual demand. These loans may be made on notes, bonds, mortgages and other sound securities commonly classed as frozen assets, so termed because they could not be used as collateral for loans from the Federal Reserve banks as now constituted.

The result of the Association's activities will mean not only help for banks, as the work will help tremendously in establishing property values and toward improving business by restoring confidence and eliminating fear of instability.
