Women's Auxiliary Has Giant Task In Supporting Charity Work At St. Joseph's

The almost gigantic task of supporting St. Joseph's Hospital in the great amount of charitable work it does each year, and which has been increasing annually during the past few years with depression's drain on the family savings, belongs to an organization of about 200 women from all parts of the county, banded together for the common purpose of helping others. Several Birmingham and Bloomfield Hills women have been active in the organization since its formation shortly after the hospital was opened in 1927.

The enormity of the Auxiliary's task arises from the fact that money earned from pay patients does not suffice in any but the slightest degree to care for the amount of charitable work the hospital is called upon to do. The difference falls to the burden of the Auxiliary to supply, assisted by the staff physicians who conduct the hospital's clinic and treat charitable cases without pay.

Some idea of the importance the clinic bears to Oakland County's indigent who are suffering from ailments and infirmities is shown by the fact that during the last fiscal year, 2,003 new cases were examined, 2,158 treatments were given and a total of 2,188 visits were made.

The work of the Auxiliary includes supplying the equipment and furnishings for the clinic. An eye trial case, a Holly examination table, glasses, light therapy equipment and dressings are a few of the needs which have been thus supplied. Furnishing a nurses' home was another of the Auxiliary's jobs.
