Approach of Tournament Recalls History of Club

When the Michigan Professional Golf Association holds its annual tournament at the Birmingham Club Sept. 12-15, it will be the fourth time in the history of the club.

Many will recall the first four tournaments of the F. G. A. in 1930, when Walter Hagen set the course record of 72, just enough to win the tournament.

That evening was the initial major tournament staged on the course.

Club members are looking forward to the tournament with the enthusiasm of celebrants.

As far as is known, there is no golf tournament in the country.

At that time the course included only nine holes. For a club, the members used a desert landscape. Northland Avenue runs across the road from the present property.

Within two years, due to the growth of the infant organization, the course was expanded to 18 holes, and the membership limited to 25. At that time, too, the clubhouse was abandoned for the former framers' house, which was added in 1925 for tennis court facilities and increased locker space.

In 1927, the sentiment of members required the favor of taking every possible step to improve the club property. As a result, Mr. Biddle was retained and the present nine holes were laid out, but the original nine holes were left in the ground.
