COVERT ROAD TAX EXPLAINED

Parry Describes Gains To Village From Relief Legislation

(This is another of a series of articles written by the village manager on topics related to Birmingham's municipal affairs.)

The assessments for Covert roads built in Oakland County have been divided in three ways: (1) The district benefited (2) the county at large and (3) the township at large. In general, the proportions paid have been 50 per cent by the district, 25 per cent by the county at large and 25 per cent by the township at large. Since the village is a part of two townships, all village properties pay of this township at large assessment on the basis of their proportion of the total township assessment.

If a piece of village property lies within two townships, the assessment, of course, is direct assessment in that district. All village properties pay in the county at large proportion and the township at large proportion. The actual burden on village property because of these two shares is hard to determine accurately, but is probably in the neighborhood of \$300,000 spread over an eighteen-year period.

This tax has been a direct tax against property and for the action of the special assessor of the county. The village has retained 50 per cent of the total assessed value of the property in the county at large and the township at large. 'Prohibition Hysteria' Seen As 'Political Smoke Screen'

Philosopher Believes 'Capitalistic Bosses' of Plotting Dictatorship

NEW YORK-Prohibition hysteria is merely a "political smoke screen" behind which the Republican and Democratic parties and their "capitalistic bosses" are plotting an economic dictatorship and coalition government before 1936 unless the people seize control of government, according to the view of Dr. John Dewey, Columbia University's famous philosopher and liberal.

Dr. Dewey launched a three-part movement on the political seas of America in Cleveland recently at the annual convention of the League for Independent Political Action. Another meeting of the league, a complete organization of the new party, will be called in 1935.

"The task of forming a new party is not an easy one," Dr. Dewey said. "We do not desire to build a party on a temporary discontent nor on temporary remedies and patchwork measures. It is our task to educate the American public to fundamental economic realities and the necessity of a new political order so that the spirit of democracy can have a re-birth."

Blames Capitalism

"Capitalism, the controlling factor in the makeup of both major parties, which we believe are being 'sold out' in national convention at Chicago, has wildly exaggerated the degree of stimulus which the repeal of the eighteenth amendment would have to employment and farm and industry."

"The two old parties mostly are riding behind this smoke screen of prohibition hysteria while capitalism leads the nation swiftly toward economic dictatorship and coalition government."

Amalgamation of all liberal elements under one banner is the objective of the third party movement initiated by the league. A comprehensive economic program is being developed which will result in economic dictatorship and coalition government.
