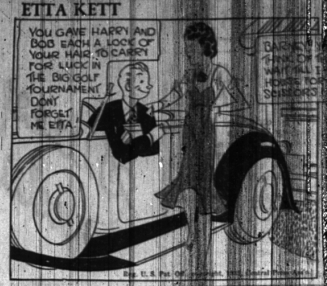
BIG BEAVER
