

POLICE ARREST 79 IN MONTH

Criminal Violations Continue At Low Ebb During November

Criminal violations continued at low ebb in Birmingham during November, only 79 arrests being made, all for misdemeanors, according to the monthly report of Miss Carrie M. Stoddard, police clerk, issued today.

Fines collected at the violations bureau amounted to \$104.

The arrests, the great majority of which were, as usual, for violations of traffic ordinances, included 56 for speeding, 13 for drunk driving, three for investigations, one for leaving the scene of an accident, one for reckless driving, two for failure to carry an operator's license, one on a warrant for another jurisdiction, five for overtime parking, two for double parking and 12 for violation of other parking regulations.

Two persons were injured in 13 traffic accidents in the village during the month. Police answered 36 calls and investigated 86 complaints. Four persons were bitten by dogs, and 27 persons were given lodging in the village lock-up.

Fire breaking and entering were reported during the month, together with one grand larceny and seven simple larcenies. Of the latter, one was proved to be unfounded, while the goods stolen in another were recovered.

DEFECTIVE HEATER BLAMED FOR BLAZE
