River valley was to locate a spot for his new settlement. While making his way through the deep forest on a high hill, seeking the trail to Charlotte, Reverend Shipherd's horse (strife) came back to the summit of the hill. Believing that the hand of Providence was in the incident of his repeated circling of the rise of land, the man of God said to himself: "The hand of the Lord is in this! Is not this green hill-top the chosen mount of consecration? the very spot whereon He would have me rear the holy altar to Learning and Religion? Surely God hath directed my stumbling steps!" He leaped from his horse and, upon bended knees, sought through prayer the guidance of Deity in his undertaking. Returning to Oberlin, he led westward to this "hill," which he called Olivet, in reverence to Jesus' consecration of the Mount of Olives, a little band of 30 people.

Falls over at Olivet are proud of their educational institution. Dr. James King, president, joins with faculty and student body in paying tribute to the fine traditions of Olivet College. They point out that many illustrious men and women have emerged from its consecrated halls, among whom are Judge Landis, Paard of the Michigan Supreme Court; Seth Q.
