HOLD LAST RITES FOR J. P. GARWOOD
Burial in Philadelphia. Follows Death From Pneumonia Attack

Funeral services were held in Philadelphia Friday for Justice Garwood, who died at his home, 16, following an attack of pneumonia. Mr. Garwood, who was 40 years of age, was a resident of Birmingham for the past two years, coming here from Chatham, N. J. He was the husband of Mrs. Margaret C. Garwood, and the father of Justice, 13 years old.

Other members of his family include his mother, Mrs. J. B. Garwood of Pasadena, Cal., a brother, Henry B. Garwood, also of Pasadena, and a sister, Miss Alice J. Garwood, director of the Little Theater in Galveston, Tex.

Mr. Garwood was the illuminating engineer for the Detroit sales office of the incandescent lamp division of the General Electric Company. He was a graduate of Swarthmore College, and a member of the Birmingham Tennis Club.

VILLAGE GETS RENTAL BOOM
Leases Here in Past Month Set New Record, Raymond Says

Though new building activity is almost at a standstill, and sales of houses are down in proportion to those in other lines, rentals in Birmingham this spring are more numerous than at any time during the past several years, according to W. Whiting Raymond, president of the Birmingham Real Estate Board.

"There have been more houses actually rented in Birmingham in the past month than any previous month since before 1929," Mr. Raymond said in a statement yesterday.

"Since the first of the year, Birmingham realtors have leased numerous houses, several to families coming to the Detroit area from other cities. I believe Birmingham has gotten more than its share of new families, due to the fact that desirable homes have been more available here than in most of the other suburbs of the Detroit area."

Rents, extremely low at the first of the year when the almost unprecedented activity began, are reacting to the available supply of demand, and are now on the upward trend, Mr. Raymond believes.

"Prices are on a much lower level than in past years," he said, "but activity is sufficient for this time to indicate an improvement in the general market."
