

# POLICE LIST DOG-OWNERS

Record Of Complaints Received Is Shown To Commission

Exhibit A at the Commission meeting Monday night was a list drawn up by Chief of Police John P. Hackett of the dog owners in the village from whom he had been complained of in the police because vicious, destructive or noisy.

The list showed that 65 such complaints have been received in the past four months, 1 to May 16, some dogs being complained of from three to four different times.

The complaints included 13 against vicious dogs, and 20 against dogs which were barking, barking. Other complaints involved attempts to bite, harboring female dogs, barking and chasing children. One such complaint was listed the name of the dog complained of, and his address.

of Village Manager James W. Parry, restricting petitioners to sign legal complaints in justice court against the owners of dogs they find roaming at large. Every citizen will be allowed to sign complaints, as usual, and unlicensed and dray dogs will be impounded and destroyed at the end of 72 hours if not claimed by their owners.

In explanation of the list of dog-owners displayed to the Commission Monday, Chief Hackett said: "The dogs belonging to the most complaints are the ones most objectionable in the village. We intend to start en- gaging the services of the police to bring in a few of them. We should be able to convince the others that we intend to keep all dogs from off their owners' property and to claim those vicious dogs which can't be trained to stay at home."

the Oakland County Tuberculosis Hospital, Mrs. Pappas declared: "We have nothing to do with the seal sale, nothing to do with the seal sale," she said, adding that the seal sale has nothing to do with the hospital and County Hospital for tubercular patients. ## Not Fault Finding

"It is our purpose to see that the unfortunate in the country are taken care of, and possibly we are not interfering or meddling, but if the men don't care to be intelligent about investments, it's the government's job to watch these matters and bring the country back to prosperity."


