Those hucksters who sell their wares from trucks or wagons along township highways may be asked to procure a license to continue in business, so as a postscript to the question, the question was brought up for discussion by the Bipartisan Township Board at a meeting Monday afternoon.

Judge Floyd S. Buck suggested that the Board consider a model license to be drafted by the township attorney, pointing out that some kind of supervision is needed to prevent the creation of dumping roadside stands developing into a major traffic hazard and from interfering with native enterprises.

Said the judge: "It would not concern taxpayers in the township who desire to sell farm produce or other wares from stands erected on their own property, it was indicated.
