factor will be authorized to make and offer for sale hangers, cards, and stickers provided that he agrees to conform to regulations to prevent the emblem coming into hands of employers not authorized to use it...

NRA Interpretations Clear Up Points Regarding Re-employment Agreement

Countless questions have been raised as to exactly what certain provisions of the President's re-employment agreement mean, and their application shall be in immediate effect.
Many of these questions have already been turned over to the National Recovery Administration, which has announced a series of interpretations issued at various times from Washington.

Maximum hours fixed in Paragraph 2 and 3 of the agreement do not apply in an employer receiving more than \$35 per week and who is acting primarily although not wholly in a managerial or executive capacity.
(5) Not to pay any of the classes of persons mentioned in Paragraph 2 less than \$15 per week in any city of over 250,000 population or in the immediate trade area of such city...
