CITY ASKS CUT IN LIGHT BILL

Would Darken 86 More Lamps For \$4,906 Yearly Saving

Removal of 86 more street lights, including lamps on Woodward and Maple avenues, around the Civic Center and in 25 residential districts, has been requested by the Commission in a letter sent to officials of the Detroit Edison Company by City Manager James W. Barry.

The letter points out that the present annual lighting bill of \$12,000 has been included in the new budget for street lighting for the year beginning July 1 and that removal of the 86 lights referred to will reduce the present annual lighting bill of \$12,000 to the \$12,000 figure.

Six 1500 candle-power lamps on Woodward avenue, leaving 14 of service; two 600-candle-power lamps at the East Maple street grade separation; five 600-candle-power lamps on Maple street; 14 ornamental lamps around the Civic Center; 17 600-candle-power lamps on Woodward avenue between Lincoln and Clawson roads; and three 100-candle-power street lamps.

About one-fifth of the lamps now in service in residential areas are asked to be darkened, Mr. Barry said.



Teachers Receive \$1,500 On Back Pay

Board of Education Apportioned "Sam Emswold" District Employees

Teachers and other employees of the Birmingham public schools have received checks totalling \$1,500 during the past week to apply against their unpaid salary balances.

The payment was voted by the Board of Education last Thursday night, to be apportioned equally among all teachers and employees. Up to that time, the Board had been banking holiday until the end of the school year when it negotiated a loan to be able to meet salaries in full for the last two weeks of the term.

On motion of F. P. McKinney, trustee, the Birmingham National Bank and Wabek State Savings Bank were both designated as depositories for Birmingham school district funds.

Tests Reveal Eight Tuberculosis Cases

Positive evidence of tuberculosis was found in only eight out of the 738 students in the Birmingham schools to whom tuberculin tests were given last month, according to reports submitted to the tests by Dr. William Lloyd Kemp, city health officer, to the Commission and Board of Education.

Only 38 students reacted positively to the tests, Dr. Kemp said. These were all X-rayed and eight in whom positive findings were disclosed were referred to their family physician or to the Oakland County Tuberculosis Clinic.

Students of junior and senior high school age were all given the tests. The undertaking was substituted in place of the usual half-day clinic for pre-school children.

Messages, with 56 cases reported, led the list of contacts in the city during May, according to Dr. Kemp's regular monthly report. Nineteen cases of shipwreck were reported, eight of shipwreck, seven of chicken pox and four of scarlet fever.


