Long Beach Resident Describes Disaster to Kin Here

A dramatic first-hand account of the earthquake in southern California is contained in a letter recently by Mr. and Mrs. Beale, 712 Catalina drive, from their mother, Mrs. Ada Beale, a resident of Long Beach, one of the principal centers of the disturbance.

Mrs. Beale escaped unharmed except for a shock and a destruction of the electrical stand her left her in a highly nervous state. ... I can tell you what I have gone through. Mrs. Beale writes in the letter that on Saturday, Mar. 11, she was away from the house for about an hour.
