STUDY BERYL MUST BE QUIET

Radio Should Be Turned Off When Child Does Home Work

Of particular importance is the psychological atmosphere of the room during the study period. If the teacher insists on home work, parents should respect the study needs of children and not make a nuisance of themselves or permit other children to make them during the study hour.

Under no circumstances must the home study period be prolonged. If the teacher insists upon sending home more work than the child can accomplish within an hour or so, the parent is within his rights to protest.
