**Burglary Suspect Told To Leave City**

Harry Jackson, 22 years old, arrested last week as a suspect in connection with recent burglaries in Birmingham and Bloomfield Hills, was arraigned Saturday before Justice H. Augustus O'Dell, pleaded guilty to a charge of trespassing and was ordered to leave the city.

Jackson, who has lived alone in a shack on the old Grand Trunk right-of-way, between Trowbridge and East Long Lake roads, since last May, was turned over by Birmingham police to Bloomfield Hills for arraignment on the trespassing charge after attempts to produce evidence against him in the burglaries were unsuccessful.

**CITIES TO MEET WITH TOWNSHIP**

Second Conference On Division Of Assets, Liabilities May Be This Week

A meeting of representatives of the Cities of Birmingham and Bloomfield Hills and Township may be held some time this week for a conference on the division of joint liabilities and assets made necessary by the cities' withdrawal from the township, the Bloomfield Hills Commission was informed Tuesday night by Harry S. Starr, city assessor.

Mr. Starr was appointed last spring to represent Bloomfield Hills in the settlement, and the Commission Tuesday night named Commissioner Luther D. Allen, a former Bloomfield Township supervisor, to assist him. Commissioners E. W. Osborne and Frank S. Packard are representing Birmingham in the negotiations.

One preliminary meeting has already been held, and the exact date of the next one is pending completion of additional data asked from Supervisor Perry A. Vaughan on delinquent taxes and other details, Mr. Starr said.

"It will be the liabilities, not the assets that will cause any difficulties," he said.

Mayor Donald D. James suggested that a reduction in the township's contract for purchase of the park from the state might be possible, and offered to confer with state officials in the matter.
