IN MANY CASES Strangers without reliable credentials are locators or "apotters" for professional criminals and according to police records lack of caution on the part of the house-

holders in admitting such strangers has often resulted in costly property losses and bitter

DO NOT PAY CASH IN ADVANCE to strangers on any merchandise—in many cases the customer HAS NEVER RECEIVED ANY-

THING for his cash advanced—nor has there been any refund made of initial deposit.

DO NOT CASH CHECKS FOR STRANGERS

-Or issue a check to a stranger as a down pay-ment-in a number of instances these checks have been "altered" and later cashed by a third

IT'S BETTER TO BE SAFE THAN SORRY-

Be SURE you know who the stranger is at your door before allowing admittance to the home. IN CASE YOU ARE SUSPICIOUS—Phone the Police AT ONCE Phone No. 1000, as we are






