

Long Illness Fatal To C. H. Sutherland

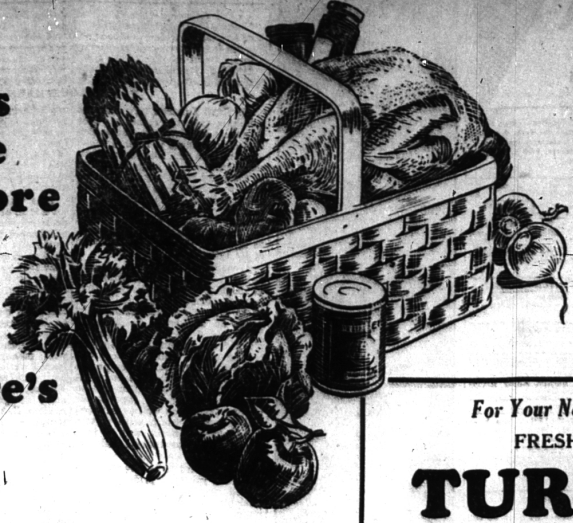
