by trick, of 12 cases of grand larceny reported, two were unfounded, one was cleared by an arrest, and the goods taken in three were recovered. A case of simple larceny reported numbered 99, of which two were unfounded, one was cleared by an arrest, and the property stolen in 21 was recovered.

425 Speeders
Arrests for speeding in 1933 numbered 425, as compared with 539 in 1932. Other traffic violations included 30 for drunk driving, 188 for illegal parking, 283 for violating traffic signals, 16 for reckless driving, one for cutting through a funeral procession, one for driving on the wrong side of the street, four for driving with four persons in a coupe, 10 for carrying improper license plates, five for driving without an operator's license, and 12 on traffic warrants.

Twenty-five of the persons arrested in 1933 were juveniles. Three of these were arrested for stealing automobiles, one for driving on a suspended license, and one for driving on a license for which he was not qualified. Arrests on felonious charges included the following:
Abandonment and desertion; 1, automobile theft; 2, breaking and entering; 1, carrying concealed weapons; 1, embezzlement; 1, fraud; 2, larceny; 1, perjury; 1, robbery armed; 1, violation of parole; 1, and for U. S. Secret Service investigation.

Police answered 1,372 calls during the year, and investigated 613 complaints. A total of 634 homes were patrolled while their owners were away, and 247 persons were given free lodgings in the city lockup. Sixty persons were reported missing, there was one raid, and 97 persons were bitten by dogs.
