Children Must Be Taught Restraint, Myers Insists

NEAR THE END of a term, a mother in one of my college courses for parents said: "I guess we are not only trying to rear our children to be good husbands and wives, good fathers and mothers."

The emphasis in parent education has been entered almost solely on sympathy and understanding of the child, with the

Dr. Garry C. Myers hopes that he might be able to balance these two attitudes toward them. The assumption has been that, essentially, children would take care of themselves, that the child just naturally would learn self-control through reason.

For the first time, particularly by Freud, there has prevailed the teaching that restraints are not desirable, but rather to be despised and avoided lest they might enfeeble nervous and fear complexes in the individual. By some magic, the child is supposed to develop self-control entirely from within, never to have it imposed upon him from without; hence the infant should be allowed to do about as he pleases and by and by be reformed.

My own contention long has been that we make our desirable efforts at sympathy and understanding in effect by failing to balance them with adequate restraints established very early in the child.

Apparently we are reaping some of the results of this teaching of no-restraints, in increasing crime
