Rule of Privileged Class Perils U.S., Speaker Says

Contemporary ideals of citizenship "must be inoculated with a good dose of Christian idealism" before America will be freed from the exploitations of selfish interests which almost brought the country to ruin in the past decade. This was the thesis of a sermon preached to the graduates of Kingswood and Cranbrook Schools at a joint baccalaureate service Sunday morning in Christ Church Cranbrook by Dr. Albert W. Beaven, president of the Colgate-Rochester Divinity School. Reminding his listeners that they are coming into citizenship in a democratic government at a time when the world has grown less safe for democracy than at any other time during the past 2000 years, Dr. Beaven declared the situation is one demanding more unselfish leadership and a great increase in the number of people who will think for themselves and act for the good of others. "It's a very questionable thing whether we are stimulating thinking today at all," he said. "We are becoming more and more mass minded at the very time when the instruments of propaganda are increasing and the need for individual thinking is becoming more acute." The need for independent thought is even secondary to the need for unselfish action, however, Dr. Beaven asserted. "We have plenty of people who are thinking," he said, "but the particular point of our need is to develop within those who do and will think a willingness to dedicate themselves in action for the good of others. We must either do this or produce another crop of crude, selfish exploiters." "What we need is not simply brains in government, but the tremendous dedication of self to the good of all," he continued. He deplored the fact that politics in America has the reputation of being "so dirty" that young people of high character and intelligence will have nothing to do with it. "America is damned today by people who have leadership, but lead the wrong way," he declared, "maintaining that privileged interests have held sway for so long at the expense of the unprivileged that

the only salvation lies in a sweeping new conception of the ideals of citizenship, a conception based on the Christian principles of unselfishness and love for mankind. "Citizenship, in days past, became a privilege instead of a responsibility, and that is the way of American disintegration if it continues," he warned. Eccentric Advs. Get Results.
