### Fourth Student Reports She Was Accosted On Way To School

Police today are investigating the complaint of another mother whose daughter reported she was accosted by a stalker man as she went on her way to school. Three reports were received by police here last week.

The latest complaint was made Tuesday afternoon by Mrs. Leon A. Chamblade, 477 Westchesterway, who said her 11-year-old daughter, Shirley, was accosted on Fairfax road near Oak street as she was on her way to attend classes at Quorton School at about 1 P. M.

The man was described as being about 40 years old, and wearing a brown suit and cap. The girl said she started running when she saw the man when he asked her to get into his car, and that he drove on. This description did not correspond with any of those given by the three girls who said they were molested last week. Chief John P. Hackett said. The three were all students at Baldwin High School.

Two of the incidents occurred near the corner of West Maple avenue and Chester street, and apparently involved the same man. The third occurred on East Maple near North street.
