## Highly Gifted Child Likely To Be A Behavior Problem

TO BE A GOOD parent or a good teacher of a gifted child must be a great accomplishment. I recently participated in a conference on "The Gifted Child as a Behavior Problem," at the annual meeting of the International Council for Exceptional Children, held at Baltimore, Md. Dr. Elmer E. U. S. Office of Education was chairman. One member who heads an adjustment program for a seven-year-old child, told me that he had an I. Q. of over 200 (from 90-110 considered normal).

Although this child has no known physical handicap, he had never fed himself, dressed himself, nor acted on himself in the normal manner, and was only slowly acquiring such self-help. From the time he was 18 months of age he was read to while fed, until recently he appeared almost hopelessly unable to adapt himself to other children.
