**HENRY ASSAILS  
PUBLIC APATHY**

Assistant State Superintendent  
Says Legislature Can  
Be Moved

"The greatest obstacle to sound educational legislation is public apathy. If the Legislature believes its constituency wants a sound school program, we will get a sound school program," declared Mr. David Henry, assistant state superintendent of public instruction, speaking before a small audience in Baldwin High School Thursday night. The meeting was called by the executive committee of the Birmingham Teachers' Club. Earlier in the day Dr. Henry addressed a combined meeting of the Rotary, Exchange and Lions Clubs in the Community House.

"Up to the present," he asserted, "we haven't convinced the Legislature we want a sound school program sufficiently to be willing to be taxed for it. Your legislators will respond to public opinion. This community and others nearby ought to make certain that your representatives understand your position clearly."

He urged local school problems be considered in the light of the state-wide educational emergency, and asked specifically for support of the Thacher-Slack bill. He fore the Legislature, which would provide \$25,000,000 annually for public schools in Michigan.

Permanent State Support of Education is necessary, he said, because the basic tax structure has collapsed, through enactment of the Thacher-Slack bill, and property tax delinquency, and decrease in valuations. He assailed legislators who consider school for school programs a "racket" spun by school educators.

"This is not an educators' program," he declared. "The schools don't belong to the teachers, they belong to the children. The feeling of your legislators that this is all a racket is the most serious obstacle to helpful legislation. The whole question of political maneuvering in educational legislation is bad. We will never have a satisfactory educational program until education is taken out of politics."

Maintaining that \$25,000,000 for operating expenses is not an unreasonable request for the schools, he pointed out that where the property tax for four years ago provided \$80,000,000 for education, and the primary fund an additional \$10,000,000, total of \$90,000,000, the property tax last year raised only \$27,000,000, and the primary fund had dropped to \$14,000,000. State aid last year amounted to only \$8,500,000. This year, Dr. Henry said, it would total \$11,000,000 or \$15,000,000.
