4 Groups To Sponsor Annual Training Classes, Opening Feb. 12

The annual Birmingham Training School for church workers will be held in the First Methodist Church, beginning Tuesday evening, Feb. 12. It has been announced by the Rev. L. Earl Jackson, publicity chairman.

Four churches are co-sponsoring the school this year: the United Presbyterian, Eastern Methodist, First Methodist and First Baptist. Teachers, officers, parents and young people from other churches, however, are invited to enroll.

The classes will meet on alternate nights over a 10-day period—Feb. 12, 14, 16, 20 and 22. This will make a less intensive schedule than in former years, and will afford more time for study between sessions. Mr. Jackson pointed out that the Rev. Dr. R. B. Hopkins, pastor of the First Methodist Church, will be dean of the school.

Three courses will be offered, all taught by competent instructors from outside Birmingham. The Rev. Frederick G. Paley, area director of education for the Methodist Church, will give a course on the church's educational program.
