15 cents each. Each ticket is good
for one ride between the depot and
any place within the city limits,
and both cab companies are re-
quired to offer the tickets for sale.
Reynolds submitted the report
as proof that the regulation com-
pelling cabs to meet the trains
causing the cab owners to lose
money. His demand that it be
reconsidered, along with the use
of special rate tickets to train users,
was backed by Commissioner Ar-
thur J. Kane, who contended that
Grand Trunk commuters are en-
titled to no more special consid-
eration than users of Eastern Michi-
gan buses.

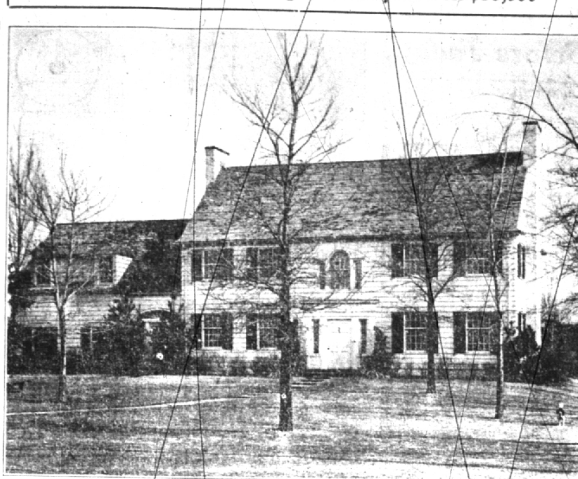
Commissioner Lawrence Hal-
pert, who was one of the chief
opponents of the regulations
favoring patrons of the Grand
Trunk suburban service, also
favored a revision. "I think we've
given it a fair test now, and don't
relieve us an ask them to keep it
up any longer," he said, referring
to the regulation requiring cabs
to meet the afternoon trains.

Mayor Harry Allen suggested
that the Grand Trunk Railroad
might be willing to subsidize the
cab companies for service to train
users at the depot.

In recommending that action be
deferred until the next meeting,

the matter had been received from
Venon, president of the Grand
Trunk Company, and suggested that
a solution might be found in a
conference session of the inde-
pendent.
