

RELAY BEATS CRANES AGAIN

Nichols School Takes Last Event To Win Meet At Buffalo, 65 1/2-56 1/2

For the second successive week, the loss of the 880-yard relay, the last event on the program, defeated the Cranbrook School tracksters when they bowed to Nichols School at Buffalo last Saturday 65 1/2 to 56 1/2.

For the first three laps of the relay, the Crane runners were leading, and at the beginning of the fourth lap the Nichols anchor man, John Garvin, received a bad pass to give Ed Mosher of Cranbrook a lead of seven yards. But by dint of unusual sprinting, Garvin made up the loss and passed Mosher in the final yard, winning by inches.

Cranbrook led through the earlier part of the meet, but in the next to last event, the decur, Nichols took all three places to gain a lead of nearly four points. With the victory in the relay, this was enough to sew up the meet.

Captain James Packard continued to lead the Brookers in springing, piling up 13 points on the first hurdle events and a second in the shot-put. He was closely followed by his teammate, Vic Pattengill, who counted 12 points on a first, two seconds, and third. Garvin led the Buffalo aggregation with 11 counters.

WASHINGTON CLUB NOT TO BE REVIVED

School Board Votes Against Resuming Sponsorship Of Trips To National Capital

Adopting the recommendation of a special committee appointed to study the matter, the Board of Education last Thursday night voted not to revive the Washington Club as a school-sponsored activity at Baldwin High School.

The committee, composed of Superintendent Charles W. Cranfill, Principal Melvin C. Hart, and Earl G. Potter, secretary of the board, was appointed several weeks ago, after a petition, containing 35 signatures, had been presented, asking that sponsorship of annual student trips to the national capital be resumed.

In reporting for the committee, Cranfill said that body recommended "no change in the present status" of the Washington Club activity.

The School Board virtually abolished the Washington Group as a school-sponsored institution following the banking holiday in 1933, when it adopted a resolution strongly advising discontinuance of preparations for the 1934 trip. The 1933 trip was made as usual.

It was understood that the Board's action of Thursday night would not prohibit groups from organizing independently and going to Washington in a body, as about 30 Baldwin High School students did this spring.
