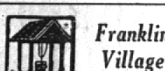

CITY SUED FOR \$5,000 DAMAGES

Attorneys For Detroit Woman Claim Severe Injuries Incurred May 5

The city of Birmingham has received notice that a suit for \$5,000 damages was filed against it Friday by Birmingham, Platte & Kries, Detroit attorneys representing Jessie B. McKinney, 4317 Commonwealth ave., Detroit.

The notice claimed that the plaintiff had received severe lacerations and injuries to both legs when a plank in a bridge at Springdale Golf Course gave way and fell through the opening. The accident is said to have occurred May 5.

"The city's defense will probably be based on Section 9 of Chapter 17, which states: 'The city shall not be liable for unanticipated damages for personal or other injuries, unless the person suffering the injury or sustaining the damage... shall serve a notice in writing upon the city within 60 days after such injury shall have occurred.'"

AGED PIONEER DIES THURSDAY

Mrs. Elizabeth H. Tuomey Was Descendant of Church Founders

Funeral services were held Saturday in Dexter, Mich., for Mrs. Elizabeth Holmes Tuomey, 83 years old, who died last Thursday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Mable Tuomey of 552 Harmon avenue, after a lingering illness.

Mrs. Tuomey was the descendant of a prominent pioneer family of Dexter, who founded the Dexter M. E. church, from which services were held. The Rev. Dr. W. R. Kinder of St. Joseph's Episcopal Church in Detroit, officiated.

After making her home in Detroit for 30 years, Mrs. Tuomey and her daughters, the Misses Mabel and Louise, moved to Birmingham seven years ago. Besides her daughters here, Mrs. Tuomey is survived by another daughter, Mrs. John J. Fredericks of Banning, Cal. She was the aunt of U. S. Senator Royal F. Copeland of New York.

Interment was in the Dexter cemetery.
