CRANBROOK BIRD BOOK IN COLOR

Bulletin Published by Science Institute Written By Dr. G. M. Sutton

Published today by the Cranbrook Institute of Science is an attractive bulletin on the feathering of sparrows, illustrated by eight color plates. Among the subjects are the Cardinal, Indigo Bunting, Towhee, and Song Sparrow in coats that few would recognize because all the birds are from but one to two weeks old and are feathered with coats that give little hint of their future brilliance. These birds are however just as pretty in their soft colors as are their more brightly marked parents.

The publication, which is titled, "Juvenile Plumage and Postjuvenile Molt in Several Species of Michigan Sparrows," is both written and illustrated by Doctor George M. Sutton, who combines a rare talent of accuracy and beauty in bird portraiture with first rate ability as an ornithologist. The text concerns such questions as: "Why should newly hatched Blue Jays be naked while newly hatched Crows are covered with down? Why should the first downy coat of the Rose-breasted Grosbeak be pure white while that of the Cardinal is grayish brown?" The presentation verges toward the technical but utilizes a vocabulary familiar to any amateur ornithologist.

The author of this book is also the author of many other works, most widely known of which is "Eskimo Year," a narrative of a winter spent in the northwestern part of Hudson Bay. Professional bird collector and curator of birds at Cornell University, but in summer is associated with the Cranbrook Institute of Science on research projects in southern Michigan.
