Jelly Recipes To Stock The Pantry

If your jelly cupboard is not as full as it should be, you should make up for lost time right away. Stock the shelves with sparkling jellies, spiced fruits and preserves.

Orange Conserve 6 lbs. of Concord grapes. Sugar. 1 lb. seeded raisins. 1 lb. seeded prunes. 2 cups nut meats. Cook grapes, press through a sieve to remove seeds. Measure and add 2 cups sugar for each 3 of pulp, juice of oranges and the raisins. Cook the mixture slowly until thick taking care not to let it scorch. Five minutes before removing from heat add nut. Pour into glasses and cover with paraffin.

Grape Jam Crush the grapes and separate the skins and pulp. Place the pulp in a closed vessel with 1 cup of water for every 5 or 6 lbs. of grapes. Cook slowly until the hulls are tender. Heat the pulp and pulp in another vessel until the pulp breaks down enough to liberate the seeds. Then put the pulp through a colander. Put the seedless pulp and hulls together. Add 1 lb. of sugar for every two lbs. of fresh fruit used. Cook slowly, stirring frequently until thick. Pack and seal in hot sterilized jars.

Fig Preserves Measure to each pound of figs, 3-4 lb. of sugar. Let stand several hours in sugar before cooking. Cook slowly until figs are transparent. Take out of syrup, fill jars. Allow figs to cool to room or thickness. Pour over figs and seal. If you like lemon slice one of the syrup while boiling.

Mint Jelly Stand overnight 1 cup minced mint, 1 1/2 cup water and 2 lbs. of sugar. Strain. Simmer 3 lbs. of peeled apples in 4 cups water until tender. Drain. Bring 5 cups apple juice to a rolling boil. Add water if needed. Stir in 1 cup sugar, powdered fruit pectin, then add 7 cups sugar, boil at rolling boil 3 minutes. Remove from fire, add mint juice and green coloring. Skim, pour and seal.

Pear Conserve 5 lbs. grape of pears. 2 lbs. sugar. 1 lb. puffed raisins. 1/2 lb. shelled nuts. Juice of 2 oranges. Juice of 2 lemons. Grated rind of 2 oranges and 1 lemon. Mix sugar and pears. Let stand overnight. Add all ingredients and cook 2 hours. Pour into jars and seal while hot.

Pear Marmalade 1 pk. pears, grated. 5 lbs. sugar. 1 quart grated pineapple. 1 pint maraschino cherries. Mix pears and sugar, let boil 2 hours. Add pineapple and cherries which have been cut fine. Let cook 5 minutes. Pour into jars and seal.

Ginger Watermelon Rind Cut rind into squares, to each pound of rind add 2 quarts of water and 1 ounce of black lime. Let stand in limewater overnight. Drain, let stand in fresh cold water 2 hours. Drain well and boil rapidly in strong ginger tea 41 ounce of ginger to 1 quart of water for 15 minutes. Drain and put into a syrup made by using 1 pint of strained ginger tea with 1 quart of sugar and 1/2 lb. of sugar. Cook until transparent and tender. After boiling 1 1/2 hour add 1 sliced lemon. Seal while hot.

Special Apple Jelly 1 quart apples. 2 cups water. 6 cups vinegar. 13 sticks cinnamon. 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves. 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg. 2 slices lemon. Sugar. Wash and slice apples. Place the vinegar water and spice in a saucepan. Bring to a boil and then add the sliced apples. Cook until the apples are soft. Strain through a jelly cloth or bug measure the juice and for each cupful measure 1/4 cup of sugar and set aside. Boil the juice for 20 minutes and then add the measured sugar. Boil until the syrup sheets from the edge of the spoon. Pour into clean hot glasses and seal.
