

AAA PROGRAM NETS COUNTY OVER \$37,000

Oakland County has received \$37,385.75 in Rental and Benefit payments in the three years since the creation of the Agricultural Adjustment Administration, according to information received by Abner E. Larned, State Director, National Emergency Council for Michigan.

Rental and Benefit payments in Oakland County for the wheat program totalled \$13,125.01; corn-hogs \$22,549.69; sugar \$1,711.03. Rental and Benefit payments in the entire State amounted to \$9,790,401.98 for the three-year period; \$909,815.83 of this amount was paid during the first five months of 1936, Mr. Larned states.
