

MAJOR DUGMORE LECTURES SUNDAY

Richard Halliburton On Program At Detroit Institute Of Arts

"The dean of all adventurers" the title Lowell Thomas has bestowed on Major A. Radclyffe Dugmore, big game hunter, artist and soldier, who will lecture at the Detroit Institute of Arts next Sunday afternoon at 3:30 and for the auspices of the World Adventure Series.

Major Dugmore earned this title on his daring photographic expeditions among the big game of the Sudan and East Africa. The motion pictures thus obtained he will show during his lecture at the institute. Close-ups of a charging rhinoceros—the stealthy stalk of a hungry lion—the watering hole which come all the wild beasts of the African veldt and jungle.

Sunday evening at 8:30, the World Adventure Series will present Richard Halliburton, one of the most popular adventure writers, who will take his audience on a word tour of the world. His audience will visit Hula Sea and with him review the Ethiopian troops—will explore the palace of Herod where Salome danced and John the Baptist was beheaded—will sit by the deathbed of the chief executioner of czar Nicholas and the Royal family and hear the true story of their execution.
