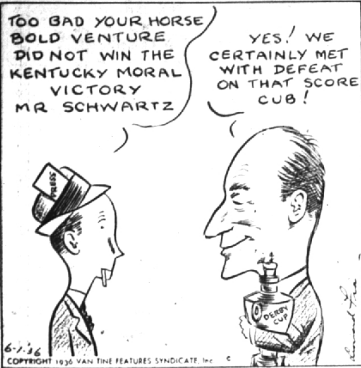

Harry L. Hopps says there is no politics in relief. Oh, well, for the next few months there'll be mighty little relief in politics, either.—Boston Herald.

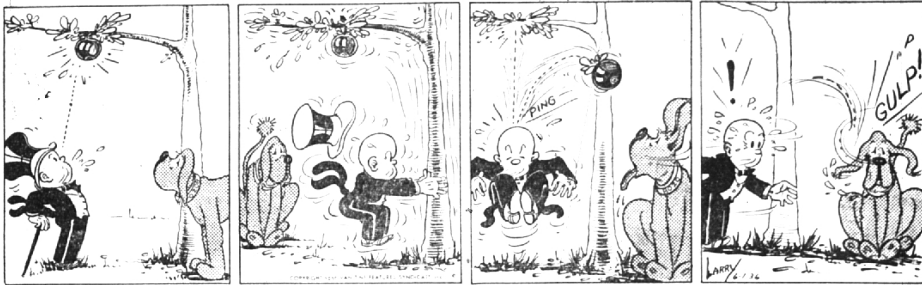
Merely We Roll Along

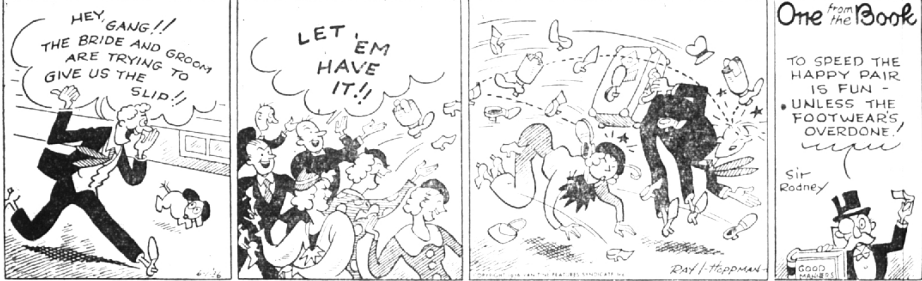

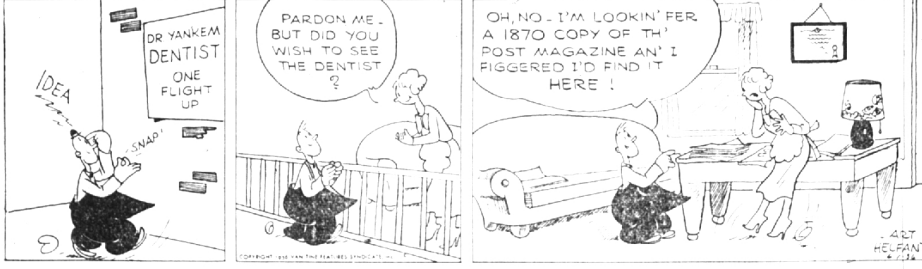
