Birmingham before today

Most of the residences on the north side of West Maple have been described to some extent in previous articles. However, there are some items of interest that were omitted. I presume that all of the over the hill residents of the town recall the frame cottage that was located about midway between the old mill and the H. A. Randall home, where Mrs. Jacobs lived for many years.

After the death of Mr. Randall the property came into the possession of Mr. and Mrs. Jacobs. Mr. Jacobs had two sons. I believe that Mrs. Jacobs was the grand daughter of "Squire" M. James. The block where the Municipal Park is now located was the property of "Squire" James and finally his granddaughter became the owner of it. After Mr. Jacobs' death Mrs. Jacobs sold the Randall property and the James property to Mr. Warren D. Cazier, father of Mrs. Marion Cazier Allen. After the death of Mr. and Mrs. Cazier the Randall place became the property of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Allen. Mr. Allen is an attorney and is a former Mayor of Birmingham. The Allen have a son and a daughter. The son is attending the University of Michigan. The daughter is at Stevens College. Mr. Allen is the son of the late John and Susie Raynor Allen whose home was at Harmon and Greenwood Aves.
