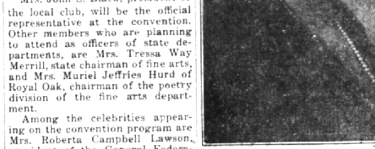
CLUB POSTPONES DATE OF MEETING
