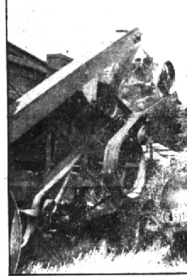

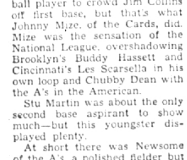
Some Mighty Fine Baseball Players Come Up This Year, Martin Asserts; DiMaggio and Mize Are Called Standouts
