Program To Include Music Of Composers Born In This Country

Mrs. Lucille Jolly of Fligt, educational director of the Michigan State Federation of Music Clubs, will speak on "American Music" this afternoon at 2:30 p. m., when the Birmingham Musicale meets at the Community House.
