

Good Cookery Is Important In Preparation of Tasty Fish Dishes

Serve With Right Combinations of Foods

More and more fish is being eaten as we learn how to market and cook it; and nowhere is good cookery more important than in fish dishes. The right garnish or sauce or both and the combination of foods with which fish is served have much to do with the popularity of fish. In the following recipe one fish may be substituted for another.

- Fish Chowder**
 2 lbs. haddock filets.
 2 slices salt pork, diced.
 1 onion sliced.
 2 1/2 cups diced potatoes.
 2 cups milk.
 2 tablespoons salt.
Pepper:
 2 tablespoons butter.
 Cut filets in uniform pieces, not too small. Fry pork until crisp, drain and cook onion in delicate brown. Strain fat into chowder kettle, add fish, potatoes, salt and pepper. Cover with cold water, bring to a boiling point and simmer until potatoes are tender. Mix flour with a little water until smooth and add to the chowder with the milk. Bring to boiling point and cook until thick. Add a few broken crackers. Serve with hot buttered cornbread, a green salad and a lemon pie.

- Salmon With Celery**
 Parboil 1 cup of celery, cut in small pieces in salted water. Make a cream sauce by blending 2 tablespoons butter with 2 tablespoons flour. Add 1/2 cup of celery water and 1/2 cup of evaporated milk. Season to taste. Fold in 1 small can (7 1/2 ounces) of salmon. Put the drained celery in a baking dish, cover with the salmon mixture. Sprinkle with butter crumbs and add a few dashes of paprika. Bake about 20 minutes until brown in an oven 350 degrees. Serve with baked potatoes, broccoli and grated raw carrot and shredded cabbage salad.

- Creamed Tuna Fish**
 Drain 1 can of tuna fish. Make 2 1/2 cups of medium thick white sauce, seasoned with a dash of curry powder, the juice of 1/2 lemon and 2 tablespoons of pimiento. Add the tuna fish and serve hot. Serve with a vegetable salad, deviled eggs and hot biscuits.

- Baked Stuffed Haddock Filets**
 3 haddock filets.
 1 cup dry bread crumbs.
 2 eggs, beaten in creaming water.
 1/4 cup melted butter.
 1 tablespoon chopped onion.
 Salt and pepper.
 8 slices fat salt pork.
 Mix bread crumbs, butter and chopped onion. Moisten with boiling water and season with salt and pepper.

Objectives Of DeMolay Organization Are Explained In Article By Chapter Member

Editor's Note: Many questions have arisen concerning the activities, initiations, educational value, and other things pertaining to the Order of DeMolay. With the objective in mind of explaining these things, the following article has been written by a local member of DeMolay. The Order of DeMolay is a fraternity, but not in the sense that that of a Greek letter society. It has secret signs, words, modes of recognition, etc., but it does not keep secret from the world its central purpose. This purpose is four-fold—(1) to create a whole new occupation for a boy's spare time, (2) to give him worthwhile associates, (3) the best environment, and (4) to provide an interesting and complete program of all-around youth development.

These Orders, numbering over a thousand in the United States and abroad, are governed by the Grand Council of the Order of DeMolay whose administrative offices are in Kansas City, Missouri. Each chapter is under the supervision of a Masonic group, and guided by an adult.

Two very impressive initiation articles immediately precede the Initiatory Degree and the DeMolay Degree. The Initiatory Degree is based on the moral and ethical virtues of the Order, which are Love of Parents, Reverence, Courtesy, Fraternity, Fidelity, Honesty, and Patriotism. Historical and spectacular is the DeMolay Degree, which portrays the trials, tribulations, and final martyrdom of the Order's founder, Jacques DeMolay.

- Fish Omelet**
 2 eggs.
 1/2 cup evaporated milk.
 Salt and pepper.
 1 cup canned or cooked fish, flaked.
 2 tablespoons fat.
 Mix eggs slightly, just enough to blend yolk and whites. Add milk, salt, pepper and fish. Melt fat in omelet pan and turn in the egg mixture. Break up with a fork until the whole is of a creamy consistency. When brown underneath, fold and turn out on a hot platter. Garnish with diced beets.

- Broiled Finnan Haddock**
 Wash fish thoroughly. Let soak in cold water, skin side up, for 1 1/2 hours. Pour off water, cover with hot water and let stand 15 minutes. Drain thoroughly and wipe dry. Brush with melted butter and broil slowly 15 to 20 minutes. Put on a hot platter, spread with butter and a little cream. Sprinkle with pepper and garnish with lemon. Serve with sliced tomatoes, cucumbers and baked potatoes.

- Cream Oyster Gumbo**
 2 dozen oysters.
 2 cups oyster liquor.
 1 tablespoon butter.
 1 pint hot water.
 1 tablespoon flour.
 1 white onion.
 Parsley, thyme and bay leaf, Salt and 1/4 pepper.
 Put the butter into a kettle and when hot add flour. When brown, add the chopped onion and parboiled oyster liquor; then add hot water. When it comes to a boil, take out of stove and stir 2 minutes; take into hot gumbo, teaspoon into into hot gumbo. Serve at once with hot rice.
