ORDINANCE NUMBER 223 City of Birmingham: An Ordinance to regulate the use of mechanical devices and establishments in the city of Birmingham.

Section 1. The City of Birmingham hereby ordains that no person shall use any mechanical device in the city of Birmingham which is not a motor vehicle, or to use any such device for any purpose other than that intended by the manufacturer.
