Michigan Mirror
NON-PARTISAN STATE NEWS LETTER

LANSING—In session now for another day, Michigan's legislature faces a heavy program of incomplete business that has prompted a decision by Gov. Murphy, Speaker George A. Schroeder and Lieut. Gov. Nowicki, presiding officer of the grind from six to eight more weeks.

The civil service bill, already passed by the senate, was sidetracked in the house by a rebellion among democrats over a "death of political" plums. Patronage "pots" is sought by leaders to swindle up hostile legislators, many of whom feel that the governor has "neglected" them in preference to the more urgent duties of speech-making in New York, Washington, and elsewhere.

Also on the administration legislative program are the following: Social Legislation—Labor relations measure giving the governor the powers of a strike dictator. Organized labor is critical of the responsibilities not found in the federal Wagner act for interstate commerce.
