Rabbit Stew

1 rabbit. 1 ounce shortening. 4 small onions cut in quarters. 1 tablespoon flour. 1 pint good red wine. 1-2 cup mushrooms. Spices. 1-2 glass cognac.

Broiled Venison

Wipe steak and brush generously with melted butter. Place on greased broiler and broil in hot oven 5 minutes...

Parley Butter

1-4 cup butter. 1-2 teaspoon salt. Pepper. 2-2 tablespoon finely chopped parsley. 3-4 teaspoon lemon juice.

Venison Cutlets

Clean and trim slices of venison cut from loin. Sprinkle with salt, pepper and parsley...

Broiled Quail

Wrap thin strips of bacon around the quail and broil under hot fire 8 to 10 minutes.

Hasen Pfeffer

(A favorite German Rabbit Dish) Cut a rabbit in suitable pieces for serving. Pack slowly in a bowl and cover with the following:

Wild Rice Timbales

Wash the rice and soak 1 hour. Steam until tender. Add butter, salt and pepper to taste.

Fried Squirrel

Cut squirrel in pieces for serving. Cover with melted butter. Let stand overnight.

Roast Wild Duck

Put in a warm room and let it completely wear off. Dress clean and stuff with sliced apple.
