Haltvorsons Buy Colonial Residence



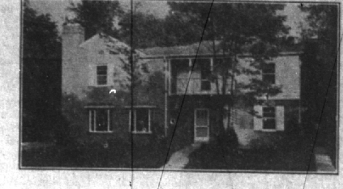
