Fish Is An Attractive Substitute For Meat And Delicious In Its Own Right

More and more fish is being eaten as we learn how to select and cook it; and nowhere is good cooking more important than in fish dishes. The right garnish or sauce or both and the combination of foods have much to do with the popularity of fish. Fish always needs a crisp vegetable salad, piquant relish or a savory sauce, and baking pan. Sprinkle with salt and pepper and brush with melted fat or oil. Bake in an oven 500 degrees until the fish is tender and jelly-like about 15 to 25 minutes, depending upon the thickness of the fish slices. Serve with cucumber sauce.

Baked Fish Fillets
Arrange the fillets on a heat proof platter or in the bottom of a baking pan. Sprinkle with salt and pepper and brush with melted fat or oil. Bake in an oven 500 degrees until the fish is tender and jelly-like, allowing about 5 to 19 minutes depending on the thickness of the fillets. Serve with parsley sauce.

Baked Fish Steaks
Have the steaks cut as thick or thin as you wish. Prepare as for baked fish fillets and bake in an oven 500 degrees until the fish is tender and jelly-like about 15 to 25 minutes, depending upon the thickness of the fish slices. Serve with cucumber sauce.
