Ham Au Gratin

Ham Baked With Dried Linas

Soak 1 cup dried linas overnight in cold water. Drain, put in a baking dish, cover with a layer of sliced onions, add 1 cup of water and top with a slice of raw ham. Bake covered for one hour in an oven 325 degrees.

Ham Ring With Peas

1 1/2 cup grated cheese, 1 cup milk, 1 egg, Pepper, Cook ham until tender and slice into 1/2 inch slices. Turn out on hot water and top with a little cold water. Add to the milk and cook for 10 minutes, stirring constantly.

Spaghetti and Ham Souffle

Cook spaghetti with tomato sauce. 1 cup dried ham, 1/2 cup butter, 1/4 cup tomato soup, 2 eggs, 2 cups flour and butter and well blended, add the tomato soup. When thick remove from fire, add the spaghetti, ham and beaten egg yolks.

Spam Onions With Ham

Parboil Spam onions for 20 minutes. Drain, split and hollow out. Fill with onion and ham mixture. Bake in a hot oven for 1 hour.
