You Can Still Serve Attractive Meals Without Being A Slave To The Kitchen

How often have we heard the housekeeper wish that she didn't have even to think of a menu much less prepare it. Meals and especially family meals, should not mean something to be gotten over in the shortest time possible.

Strawberry or Raspberry Ice

3 cups berries 1/2 cup sugar 1/2 cup water 1 teaspoon lemon juice 1/2 tablespoon lemon juice

Stuffed Tomatoes

Scoop out small ripe tomatoes, using a sharp knife, saving the tops. Salt slightly and invert and chill in refrigerator.

Browned Rice

Boil rice in well seasoned bouillon. After rice is boiled in small cooked "yellow" macaroni, multiple green peas and green string beans, cut into small pieces.

Roast Duck With Oranges

Roast the duck in the oven in the regular way. When the duck is well done, prepare in good time the formation of the sauce.

Stuffed Italian Squash

Select small, regular sized squash, wash and steam or boil until tender, cut a slice from the top and remove the seeds.

Fruit Compote

Cut up peaches, oranges, grapefruit and pineapple, chill in the refrigerator, mix together the syrup from the peaches with the juice of 2 or 3 oranges, adding sugar to sugar to give a creamy consistency.

Buttermilk Sherbet

2 cups buttermilk and 1/2 cup granulated sugar 1/2 cup crushed pineapple 1 egg white 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla

Jellied Apricot Ring (Dessert Salad)

Take 2 cups of juice of canned apricots and 2 cups of pineapple juice. Heat to the boiling point. Cook 10 tablespoons of gelatin in 1/2 cup of cold water and dissolve in the hot fruit juice.

Garbage Collection

The City of Birmingham will receive proposals for the collection of garbage from residences and business places for the fiscal year July 1, 1938-39.

Bidders shall specify the rate they propose to charge for collection from private residences on the basis of two collections per week, based on a one year license.

Bidders shall state what equipment they propose to use and must provide compensation and public liability insurance and provide cash bond in the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for faithful performance.

Bids must be in the Clerk's Office by Monday, June 6, 1938.
