NOTED ORCHESTRA TO GIVE CONCERT IN ANN ARBOR

The Cleveland Symphony Orchestra, directed by Artur Rodzinski, will give the second program in the "Sixtieth Annual Choral Union Concert Series, Monday evening, November 7, Hill Auditorium, Ann Arbor.

This organization, now in its 21st year, has a long line of outstanding musical achievements, not only by reason of its extraordinary series of concerts in its local city, but on its wide-spread tours which have included nearly a thousand programs in twenty-six states, Cuba, and Canada.

Artur Rodzinski has presided over the artistic destinies of the organization for six years. As an associate and friend of Toscanini he is selected, trained and organized the NBC Symphony Orchestra, and conducted its first ten programs. This dynamic conductor was chosen in 1933, and at the same time the scope of the orchestra's services was broadened. The organization has been heard in Ann Arbor on two previous occasions, when it was highly acclaimed.
