The root of all good government grows upward from the local community. Our city, while lacking lit-tle in the fundamentals of good government, has in common with many municipalities a degree of mattercommon with many municipalities a degree of matter-of-course-acceptance with too little understanding of the benefits we have and enjoy. The Commission-Manager method is admirably adapted to a City like ours. We feel that its beneficial results over the years that have passed and those to come would be better understood and appraised by having a day of con-ducted visitation and explanation with the city officials as hosts.

The still larger objective is a revival of genuine active interest in efficient democratic government itself, which our forefathers provided and protected under the American constitutional system. For this we may well bow our heads in thankfulness after a glimpse at some other parts of the world.

In keeping with the occasion, and to increase local interest, there is now being conducted a city and school-wide prize essay contest on a theme directly connected with the spirit of better citizenship in a free government through taking a greater interest in local government. Both spiritual and practical benefits always flow from a revival of interest in American institutions, and when centered upon local government such interest unfailingly influences state and national government.
